

SIGN UP

Children are identified through our partners at Communities in Schools, food banks, and individuals within the congregation. Parents are contacted and register for the event either through the church partner or on our website.

SHEPHERDS & MEALS

Families are introduced to a church volunteer who will 'shepherd' them through the event process which includes sitting down with them to share a meal. If the family desires, the Shepherd will also share information about the church and Christ.

SHOPPING & CHECKOUT

Shepherds will show families to the designated shoe room and help the children shop for shoes of their choice. Typically, enough shoes are provided so that children can choose from 3 styles of shoe in their size.

Afterwards, families head to a "checkout" area where children are given a bag to carry their new (or old) shoes in.

OPTIONAL EVENTS

Some host churches provide a little extra fun for the children before they leave. The activities offered depend on the season in which the event occurs. Some ideas for activities include photo booths/backdrops, kid fishing, face painting, balloon artists, games, and bounce houses.

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REGISTRATION

On the day of the event, families are checked in and receive name badges from the registration table.

SHOE & SOCK SIZING

Shepherds will take families to the sizing area where they are measured for properly fitting shoes and socks. Optional: Washing of children's feet prior to receiving new socks and shoes.

MEET THE PASTOR

Families are greeted by the Pastor and/or ministerial team. Families are provided information for the church, encouraged to attend services if they do not already. Optional: The host church may also choose to provide each family with a Bible.

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
